

## **Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Logo Contest Terms & Conditions**

1. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Logo Contest runs through October 15, 2012. All entries must be received by October 15, 2012 to be considered.
2. Entries must be submitted using the guidelines stated on the Contest Details.
3. Submitted artwork must be your original creation!
4. The Artist shall indemnify and hold the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation, the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council, and their respective employees, officers, directors, agents, representatives, successors, assigns, advertising and promotional agencies harmless against any and all liability imposed or claimed, including attorney fees and other legal expenses, arising out of actions brought by third parties based on authorship and/or infringement of intellectual property rights pertaining to artistic works submitted by the Artist under these Terms.
5. You may submit two (2) entries.
6. All contestants will be required to agree to the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Logo Contest Terms & Conditions in order to enter.
7. All artwork must refer to the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Los Angeles, CA by including, visibly and legibly, Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Los Angeles, CA.
8. All contestants must register for this contest by completely filling out the registration form with a short explanation about the drawing and agreeing to the terms and conditions of the contest. If you are under 18 years of age, than your parent or legal guardian must also sign and agree to the terms and conditions.
9. Each entry will receive a number assigned for identification purposes. Place your signature or identifying marks on the backside of the drawing in the lower left hand corner only. If we cannot cover your signature you may be disqualified.
10. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Logo Contest will be judged by the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council (with the exception of those Tribal Council Members that wish to participate in the contest and Tribal Council Chairwoman Sandonne Goad as she will be handling the entries) and Senator Richard Polanco.
11. By entering this Contest, each contestant consents to the use of his/her name, and/or artwork in any Tribal Seals, documents, stationary, merchandise, advertisements, educational materials, any items listed or unlisted, or publicity carried out or produced by the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation and its advertising and promotional agencies without further notice or compensation. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation will retain full rights to the winning drawings to use at their discretion for all tribal needs.
12. Prizes are as follows:
  - The First Place Winner will (a) receive \$100; (b) receive a t-shirt with their artwork; (c) see their winning artwork featured on all future documents, newsletters, stationary, tribal products, the website, and other items.
  - The Second Winner will (a) receive \$50; (b) their artwork featured on tribal products.
  - The Third Place Winner will (a) receive \$35; (b) their artwork featured on tribal products.Contest winners will also be acknowledged on the Tribal Website.
13. The Contest Judges' rulings are final and without appeal in all matters related to this Contest and the awarding of the Prizes. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations.
14. All winning entries become the property of the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation and will not be returned.

15. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation and the judges assume no responsibility for lost, stolen, delayed, illegible, incomplete, postage-due, garbled, or misdirected entries or entries that have been submitted through illicit means, or do not conform to or satisfy the Contest Rules.
16. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council will not share any personal data about entrants with any other party. The personal data collected for this Contest will not be used for any other purposes. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council collects your personal information for the purposes of registration and to keep you informed about the Contest.
17. By entering this Contest, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation, the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council, and their respective employees, officers, directors, agents, representatives, successors, assigns, advertising and promotional agencies from any liability for any loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person in connection with this Contest or participation in any Contest related activities, including but not limited to the use or misuse of a prize or any portion of a prize including personal injury, death, or property damage.

The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, cancel, or suspend this Contest should an external circumstances arise which are beyond the reasonable control of the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council is not responsible for any errors or omissions in printing or advertising this Contest. This Contest will run in accordance with these Contest Rules, subject to amendment by the Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council. The Gabrielino/Tongva Nation Tribal Council reserves the right to cancel, amend, modify, or terminate this Contest or the Rules at any time in its sole discretion and without notice.
19. Entrant must comply with these rules and will be deemed to have received and understood the rules if they participate in the Contest.
